



Laser Safety Information for Hospitals

LASER SAFE

This document is intended to serve as a resource for hospital directors and administrators to provide an outline of compliance requirements and training resources for Healthcare laser Safety in Hospital Environments.

Laser Safety Officer (LSO) Responsibilities¹

- The LSO must administer an in-house Laser Safety Program, including:
 - Overseeing training and certification
 - Documenting accidents and incidents
 - Maintaining Laser Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
 - Monitoring Medical Laser Device function and maintenance
- The LSO should appoint a Deputy LSO in the case of hospitals that run 24/7
- The LSO must performa hazard evaluation of the Laser Treatment Control Area (LTCA).
- The LSO must implement the following control measures:
 - Administrative Control Measures
 - Engineering Control Measures
 - Environmental Control Measures
- The LSO must ensure laser safety awareness for all personnel (staff and patients) that come into contact with a medical device or its emission hazards.
- The LSO must supervise operation of any laser device with a Hazard Classification of 3 or higher (including Class 3R, Class 3B, or Class 4²).

Note from LSC: We recommend that each hospital has at least one LSO on staff, and a second backup deputy LSO is best practice according to ANSI Z136.3. We also recommend Laser Technician Certification for all nurses and staff that work around the laser device while it is powered on.
